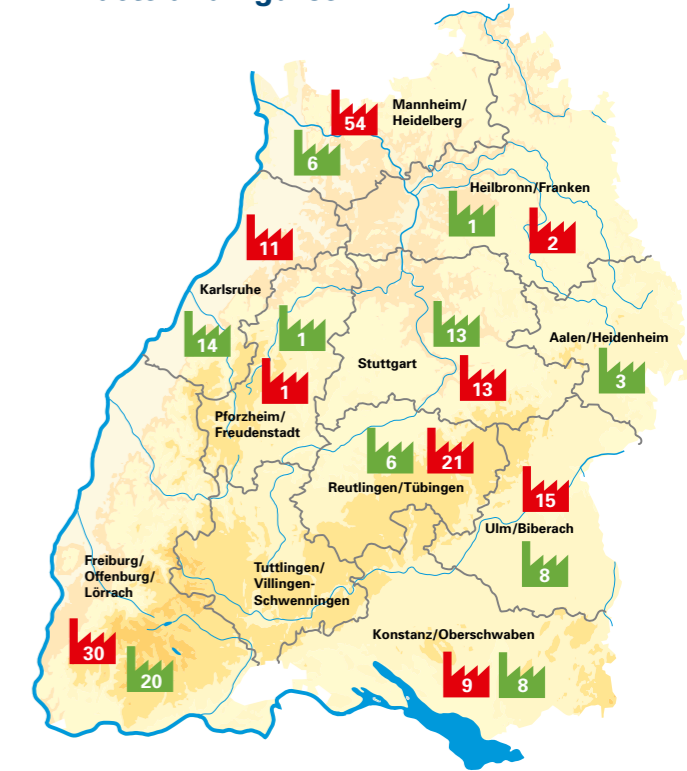

Pharmaceutical industry*

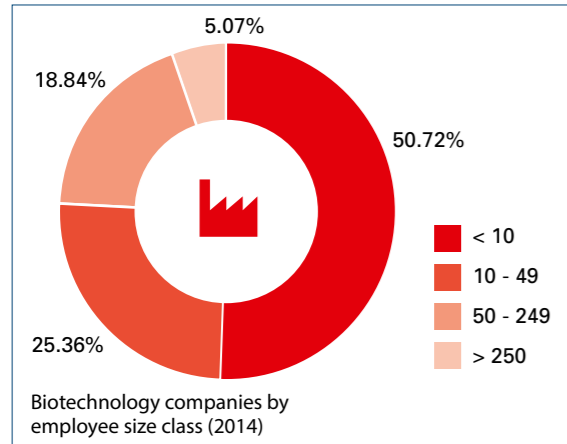
- 80 pharmaceutical companies

* The figures are from 2014 and were calculated by the Baden-Württemberg Statistics Office based on data held in the BIOPRO company database at the time of the survey. The figures only include companies that are involved in research, development and/or production in Baden-Württemberg. The Baden-Württemberg Statistics Office was able to calculate figures on taxable revenue and employees for 138 out of the 156 biotechnology companies and for all 80 pharmaceutical companies. Suppliers and pure distribution companies were not included in these figures.



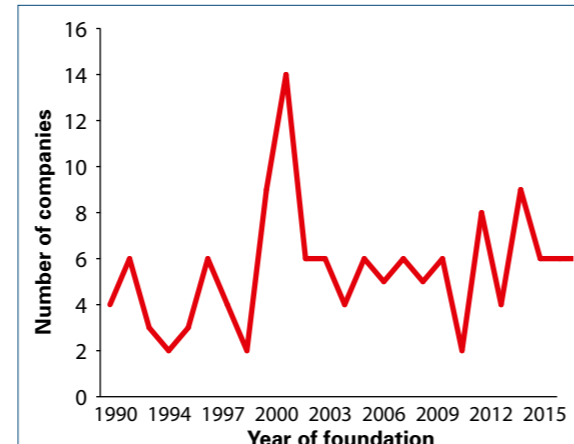

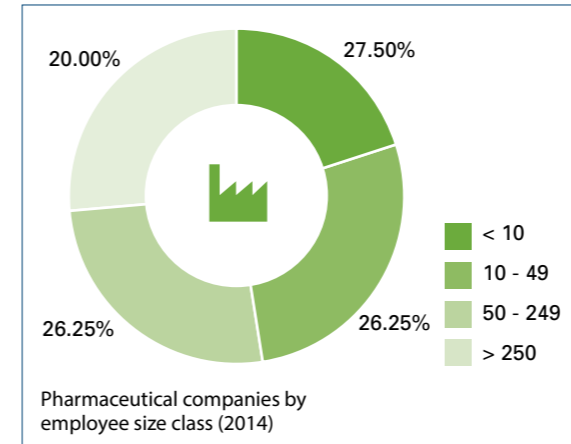
Baden-Württemberg's young biotechnology sector is dominated by **micro and small companies**.

Science-oriented and innovative



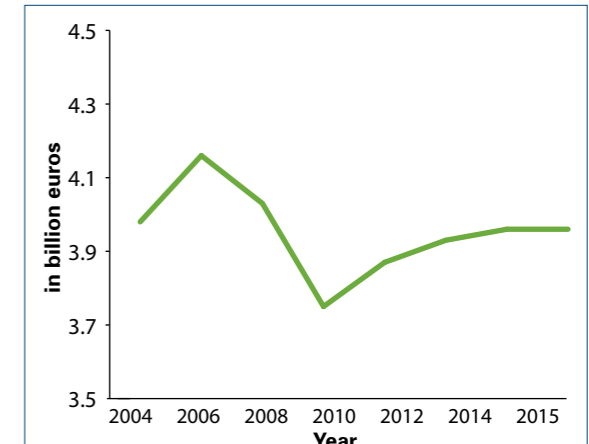
Baden-Württemberg is a first-class location for biotechnology companies. **Twelve biotechnology companies** were founded between January 2015 and July 2016.

High-revenue employment driver

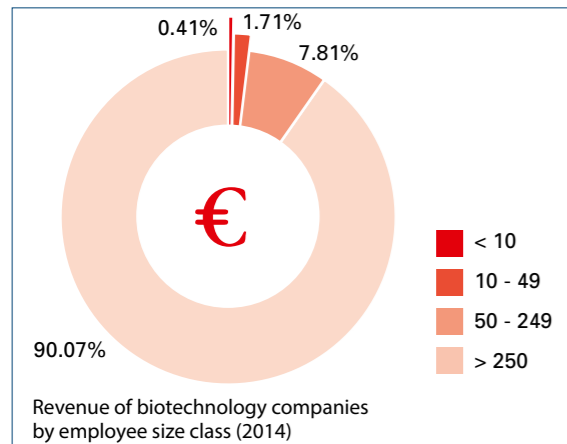

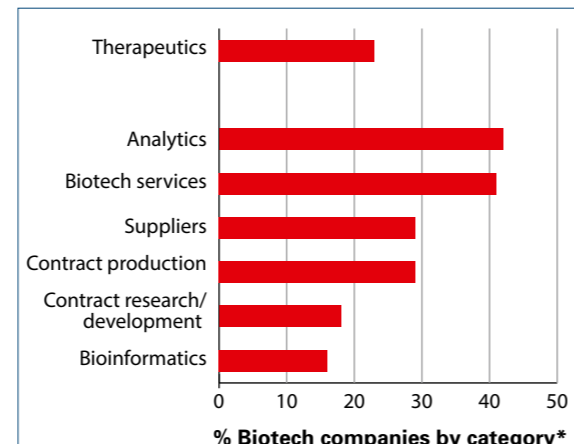
Traditional, herbal, homoeopathic



In 2015, **3.96 billion euros of pharmaceutical products** were produced. Two thirds of the pharmaceutical products are exported.

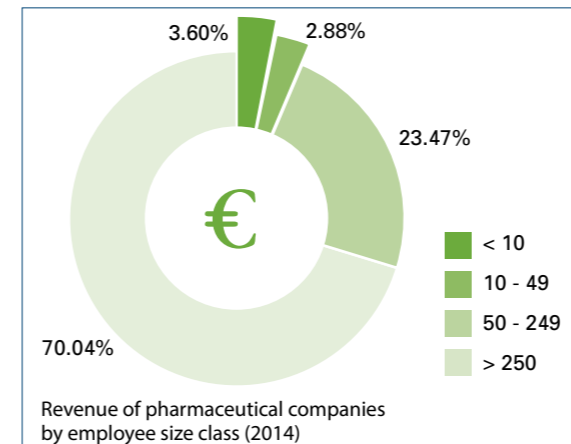


Biopharmaceutical production is a revenue driver: the largest biotechnological production plants are located in a region bordered by the Ostalb and Lake Constance districts (Ulm, Biberach and Laupheim).

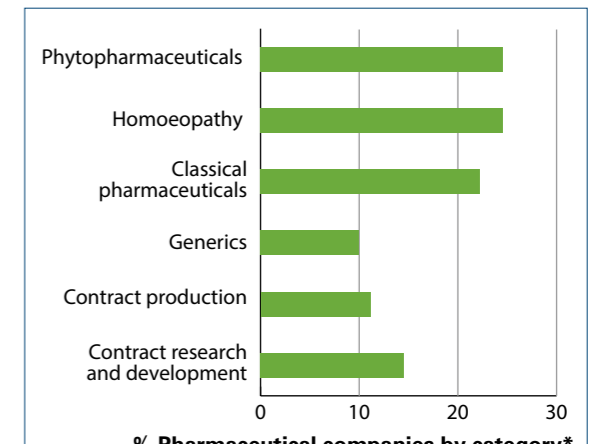


Baden-Württemberg's drug development activities centre mainly on **oncology**. Many biotechnology companies offer **technology platforms** in order to at least partially finance the time- and cost-intensive research and development of new pharmaceuticals.

R&D expenditures account for **13 percent** of taxable revenues in Germany as a whole and are higher than in any other industry (source: BPI). They reflect the complex and highly regulated area of drug development and approval.



In Baden-Württemberg there is a long tradition of producing **herbal and homoeopathic medicines**. Manufacturers such as Dr. Willmar Schwabe GmbH & Co. KG, Biologische Heilmittel Heel GmbH, WALA Heilmittel GmbH and Weleda AG have their headquarters here.
